ATTENTION: ERROR IN THE PRINTED DANCE CAMP BOOKLET!

Please note that on Friday the Boogie Woogie Intermediate/Advanced classes will take place at Alte Rotation. Our Dance Camp Booklet incorrectly states that these courses take place at the DT.01 dance school in the AWA Hotel. This only applies to Friday. The online schedules and the online booklet are correct.

COLLECTION OF YOUR ORDER

You will receive your tickets, documents and ordered products at the check-in counter. The number of pickups is particularly high on Friday and Saturday mornings and Saturday evenings. So come early. If you come to dance camp, remember that you also have to go to your class room. If you get there just before your class, you won't make it on time. Even if you are running late, you have to go to the check-in first!

Check-in at the Deutsches Theater is in the foyer of the theater. If you have only ordered evening tickets for Saturday or Sunday and you want to avoid waiting times, please use the daytime check-in at the CVJM. This also gives you the opportunity to browse the vintage market.

Attention: At the check-in and the RTSF stand only cash payment is possible!

To pick up your order, you need your order or payment confirmation + possibly your student ID (printed out or on a mobile device)!

If you don't have your confirmation with you, the pick-up process will take longer for you, as you first have to show your ID at the special counter to have your order confirmation printed out. So you have to queue twice. So don't forget your confirmation! If you can't find your confirmation, log in to the online ordering system via the website and download it.

CHECK-IN

The central contact point for all your Rock That Swing matters is the check-in. You can find the opening hours on our website. In important cases you can reach the check-in on +49 (157) 541 795 10.

If possible, please collect your tickets from the CVJM at the check-in during the day and not in the evening, so that there are no long queues and you can enjoy our evening events in good time!

In our Dance Camp booklet you will find a map with the check-in, all studios and event locations. You can also find the booklet on the homepage of our website.

BÄRBL'S BIRTHDAY

As you know, Bärbl celebrates her 60th birthday on Monday, February 20th! Many have already asked us how they can participate in a gift. We would like to send Bärbl on a well-deserved vacation! If you would like to get involved, you can put something in our piggy bank provided for this purpose. We have also created a **birthday book** for her, in which you can write your own personal congratulations. Both are accessible during the day at the check-in in the CVJM and in the evening in the entrance area of the respective event location!

PARKING AND DIESEL DRIVING BAN

In February, the gradual diesel driving ban in Munich came into force. In general, vehicles with emission standard 4/IV and worse are no longer allowed to enter downtown Munich. Please find out more about the details online.

The APCOA underground car park "Sonnenhof-Garage" (Landwehrstrasse 10) promised us a discount of 30%. You need a discount code for this. This should be available at check-in. Please note, however, that the car park only has a few parking spaces.

TICKET AVAILABILITY

Tickets are still available for the **Sugar Foot Hop on Saturday**. Any remaining tickets for the other evening events are available from Thursday at check-in and at the respective box offices.

FOOD AND DRINKS

It is not permitted to bring your own food or drinks into the restaurant rooms or during the evening events.

PLAYBILL

Gosia has created a wonderful program booklet again. The online version is already available on the website. You will receive the printed version at check-in and at the event locations. The program booklet also contains the schedules of the evening events.

DRESS CODE

In order to do justice to the atmosphere of the evening events, we ask that you dress appropriately: appropriate clothing of the 30s to 50s or elegant clothes! Expensive designer t-shirts and designer sweatpants don't count either. If you are not dressed appropriately, security may say: You can't get in here!

HEALTH CARE

If you are ill, you cannot attend courses and events. Even if you have been looking forward to the festival for so long, think about your health and the health of others. Do not risk heart muscle inflammation and do not carelessly infect others! Better to do without once than for a lifetime.

For general health protection, please wash your hands regularly and thoroughly! We have set up hand disinfection columns at the evening events. We recommend taking small disinfectant bottles with you for the courses. Handkerchiefs may only be used once by law! ;-)

HYGIENE

Perhaps the most important issue. Please take care of the shower in the morning. **Especially important: fresh breath.** We haven't had vampires in classes before, so there's no need to eat garlic before class. A strong smell of alcohol might be cool in the peer group, but it's not appropriate in the classes. **The trend is back to brushing your teeth several times** – mind you, per day. During cool and energetic hours, it is inevitable that your t-shirt will get wet. **Please bring enough fresh T-shirts to change into and fresh towels.** The T-shirt from the day before, which was only hanging on the balcony and has not yet seen the inside of a washing machine, does not pass as fresh in Bavaria. ;-) Make your mother happy!

CONTESTS

If places are still available, registration is also possible during the day at check-in and in the evening on site. If too few participants are registered for a tournament, the preliminary round can be omitted or the tournament can be cancelled. Registration in the evening closes 30 minutes before the start of the tournament. Attention! The preliminary rounds are already at the beginning of the evenings. You can find the current status on the website.

DANCE CAMP

The Dance Camp timetable shows you the classes and the respective studios. You can find the timetable online. The Mobile Schedule also has integrated route planning and also shows you the course descriptions.

PRIVATE LESSONS

Even if you don't take part in the dance camp, you can arrange private lessons directly with the teachers. The Lenbachzimmer in the Künstlerhaus is available for private lessons from Friday to Sunday during the regular Dance Camp times. The room rental is 20 euros per hour.

VINTAGE MARKET

From Friday evening to early Sunday evening you can stock up at the vintage market in the CVJM. You can also visit the market if you are not attending the RTSF. More information and opening hours can be found in the program booklet and on the website.

TAXI

You can usually find taxis easily on the street. You can order a taxi from Taxi München on +49 (89) 21 610 or from IsarFunk on +49 (89) 450 540.

EMERGENCIES

In emergencies, contact the staff or check-in. For serious emergencies, call 112 (emergency) or 110 (police).
